Thank you for your patience during this very busy summer and return to learn planning. Our Return to Learn plan is scheduled to be released to the public during the week of August 3rd. - Lisbon teachers <u>will not</u> be teaching the Virtual Home Learning option. Edmentum provides all certified teachers.
- When enrolled in the Edmentum program this is a <u>mandatory model of school, not voluntary.</u>
- When you enroll in Edmentum, this is a <u>semester-long commitment</u>. Students will not be allowed to return to in-person instruction at Lisbon Community Schools until the second semester. You will also be allowed to re-enroll in Edmentum's program for the second semester if you choose to do so.

- When you enroll in the Edmentum program, you would still be required to <u>E-Register</u> through Unified Classroom/Powerschool as you have in past years. We will continue to hold each child in our student database regardless of face-to-face learning or Virtual Home Learning with Edmentum.
- <u>To be considered for Virtual Home Learning with Edmentum you must respond to the survey indicating your interest by Wednesday, August 19th.</u>
